## FOCUSED LIVING PRAYER April-May 2019

"In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for **the trumpet will sound**, and the dead will be raised imperishable..." (I Cor 15:52)

At the funeral of Richard Nixon, our 37<sup>th</sup> President, Bill Graham told the story of Winston Churchill. Being convinced of the resurrection of Christ and the eternal life based on faith in His raising from the dead, Churchill planned his own funeral at St. Paul's Cathedral. He instructed that a bugler be positioned high in the dome of the cathedral. After the benediction, he was to play the sad melody of <u>taps</u>, declaring that the days of a man's life on earth are over. But he had also instructed another bugler to be positioned on the



opposite side of the dome. This bugler would end the service by playing the exhilarating tune of **reveille**, a call to arise to a new day. In dramatic fashion Churchill illustrated what the Scriptures proclaim. For those who put their <u>faith in the resurrected Christ</u>, our last notes will not be those of sorrowful <u>taps</u> but those of triumphant <u>reveille</u>. Nothing gets our attention like death. But nothing deserves our attention more than the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. So what will be played at your funeral?

This **Easter season** let the power of God's truth wash over your heart as you respond to Christ's gracious invitation to *"repent and believe in the gospel."* (Mark 1:15)

"He is risen!" (Matt 28:6)

"...just as **Christ was raised from the dead** by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in **newness of life**. For if we have been united with Him in a death like His, we shall certainly be united with Him in a resurrection like His." (Romans 6:4-5)

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, He has caused us to be born again to a **living hope** through the **resurrection of Jesus Christ** from the dead to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you." (1 Pet. 1:3-4)

"For I know that my Redeemer lives..." (Job 19:25)

"That you may know what is the **hope** to which He has called you, what are the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might that He worked in Christ when **He raised Him from the dead** and seated him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come." (Eph. 1:18-21)

"Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with Him. For we know that since **Christ was** raised from the dead, He cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over Him." (Rom. 6:8-11)

"If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you." (Rom. 8:11)

"That I may know Him and the **power of His resurrection**, and may share his sufferings, becoming like Him in his death..." (Phil. 3:10)

"Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised— who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us." (Romans 8:34)
